Rules:

- All diorama characters must be portrayed by Peeps marshmallows.
- Dioramas must be shoebox sized, or no larger than 18"x18".
- Dioramas must be free standing.
- Dioramas must have a title displayed on the front of it.
- All entries must be submitted with an entry form.
- The Peeps Committee reserves the right to omit any entry that is deemed inappropriate.
- Contest is open to all ages. There are separate prize categories for Children (Grade 5 & younger), Teens (Grades 6-12), Adults, and Groups/Families.

Important Dates:

- Entries may be submitted to the Prescott Public Library during business hours on Tues, March 15-Sat, March 19.
- Entries will be on display from March 21st-31st (the Library will be closed Fri, Mar 25).
- The public will vote for a People's Choice Award for their favorite diorama. Voting will take place any time during library business hours from March 21st-30th.
- A panel of local celebrity judges will select one winner from each category. This judging will take place March 21st & 22nd. All judges' decisions will be final.
- All awards will be announced March 31st.
- Entries not picked up by April 4th will be either be discarded or used for public display at the discretion of the Peeps Committee.
