In partnership with the Dakota County Star Quilters, the 22nd annual quilt show theme is "Modern Vintage." The exhibit is open during normal operating hours at the Lawshe Memorial Museum. The "Modern Vintage" exhibit consists of over 75 quilts of all sizes hung throughout the Lawshe Memorial Museum's Great Hall.
